Information on Assessments and Exams

Due to COVID-19, all North Dakota state-wide assessments for accountability have been canceled for the 2019-20 school year. This includes NDSA, NDAA and ACT.

Additionally, all ACT makeup testing dates have been canceled by the North Dakota Department of Public Instruction (NDDPI) for spring 2020. ACT has provided North Dakota 11th graders who were not able to test on the initial test date of March 3, 2020, the opportunity to take the ACT with Writing on either the June or July national test date at no cost to them. NDDPI will provide vouchers for these tests. Students will need to go to [ACT's Website](#) to register for the national June or July test date, using the voucher. On this registration site, students will be able to choose an available test center nearest to them. More information will be coming concerning the voucher request process.

College Board has provided information [on their website](#) regarding AP exams this spring. Through College Board, students have access to free resources through the exam day. Students also have the ability to cancel at no charge.
