## The City of Fargo and MinnKota Recycling Partner for 'Cans to Cartons' Recycling Challenge

**FARGO, N.D. (Oct. 28, 2021)** – During the month of November, the City of Fargo will partner with MinnKota Recycling to promote the “Cans to Cartons” Recycling Challenge. MinnKota Recycling will provide a one cent per pound match for all the aluminum cans collected at the MinnKota Redemption Center and the City of Fargo recycling drop sites during the month of November.

The one cent match proceeds from the aluminum cans will benefit the ‘Got No Milk’ programs with the Fargo Public Schools. The ‘Got No Milk’ program provides milk for elementary students for their mid-morning snack.

In 2020 the City of Fargo collected \$192.15 to the Got No Milk program at Fargo Public Schools. This donation helped purchase 549 cartons of milk for students.
