6. Do you have detention hours? Do you have math or science homework? Take advantage of the 2-for-1 special on detention by meeting with a math or science para to serve detention. Here's how it works:
- Check-in with Mrs. Dura or Ms. Mcgoldrick during an open period.
  - Tell them your first and last name, math class, and teacher.
  - Say you are serving detention.
  - Do your homework for 30 minutes and get help from the para if you need it.
  - 30 minutes homework = 1 hour detention served.
7. If you have detention hours, please make sure you have a plan to serve them.
- They add up and carry over the years. If you want to attend any upcoming dances, Prom or walk across the stage at Graduation (your senior year) you **MUST** have a 0-hour balance.
  - You can check your Detention hour balance on PowerSchool.
  - You can serve detention during period 8 (3:05-3:50 pm) or after school on Tuesdays and Thursdays (3:50-4:45 pm) in room 114. They must stay in detention for the entire time to earn 1 hour towards their total detention hours.
  - You can also work with your principal on additional methods such as: weekly attendance plans, attending Spartan Hour or attending appointments for additional academic support from Mrs. Dura (Math Interventionist) or Ms. Maura (Science Interventionist)
