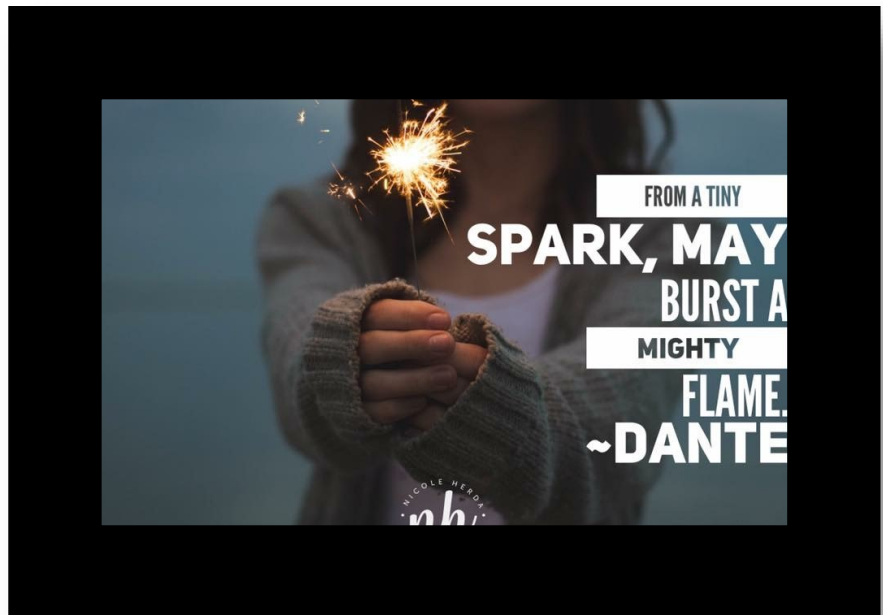
Fargo Public Schools is excited to welcome students to the kindergarten class of 2019-20 school year on August 22, 2019!
