Policy Type: Executive Limitations

Instructional Materials Selection

The Superintendent shall not fail to adopt textbooks and instructional materials that advance the achievement of the Board's *Results* policies and contribute toward continuity, integration and articulation of the curriculum by course and program.

Accordingly, the Superintendent shall not:

- Fail to ensure appropriate input from the following groups as instructional materials are reviewed and selected: teachers, administrators and other staff members involved in developing the education program. Students will be involved when appropriate.
- 2. Fail to consider the needs of all learners when selecting textbooks and instructional materials and assure alignment with district curriculum standards.
- 3. Fail to provide a procedure for the evaluation of materials and textbooks, and a procedure for reviewing such materials upon formal request by a parent or citizen
- 4. Fail to develop and implement appropriate policies governing access to and utilization of electronically distributed information

Monitoring Method: Internal report

Monitoring Frequency: Annually in February
