Good Faith Negotiations 12. Both parties will negotiate in good faith. Good faith negotiations require all parties to have dialogue about the issues, share rationales for and against proposals, issue counter proposals when possible, arrive prepared, and be able to make decisions at the table. 13. Both parties agree to use the FTEs in the salary matrix as of April 24, 2021 for cost projections. 14. Notice must be given prior to either side declaring impasse. 15. When requesting information from appropriate District officials, Chairs will be copied on the request and the distribution of the information. Any information about the budget, including current and projected salary estimates, provided to the Board in regular meetings, committees, or any other avenue will be shared with the FEA Chair. The party Chairs will facilitate meetings on an alternating basis. FEA will facilitate the May 5 meeting.
