## **FARGO NORTH JUNIORS ATTEND POST-SECONDARY PREVIEW DAY**

On Thursday, October 4, 199 North High School juniors will spend the day visiting various college campuses and military sites in Fargo, Moorhead, and Grand Forks, as part of their career exploration program.

Prior to this visit, students were given a list of six campus, sites including North Dakota State University, University of North Dakota – Grand Forks, Minnesota State University – Moorhead, Minnesota State – Moorhead, Air National Guard, and the Army National Guard. They were instructed to choose their first, second, and third choices. From there, students were assigned busses based on their choices. Each campus visit will include an admissions presentation and campus tour, and some campuses will offer department-specific tours based on the students' interests. For the students who are unsure of what to study after high school, personality quizzes will be given at a few campuses to assist in narrowing down interests. The military base visits include a tour of both the Air National Guard base and the Army National Guard facilities in Fargo, giving students a glimpse of both facilities.

These tours are part of North High School's career exploration programming, highlighting the importance for students to understand all potential paths beyond high school. North High decided to explore both military ready and post-secondary ready options outlined in North Dakota's Choice Ready framework by implementing Junior Preview Day. The goal is for students to have an understanding of entry level expectations for 2-year, 4-year, and military options after high school as a result of these tours.
