Fargo Davies High School and league rival West Fargo High School will play in their seventh annual “Dig For A Cure” Charity Fundraiser Volleyball Match on Thursday, October 11, at West Fargo High School, with matches at 4:30 p.m. (C Level), at 5:45 p.m. (Junior Varsity) and at 7:00 p.m. (Varsity). All funds raised this year will be donated to our local chapter of “Pink it Forward.”

“Dig For A Cure” t-shirts were sold for \$10.00 each prior to the event at both schools; there may be shirts available for purchase at the October 11 event if supplies are still available. Admission to the volleyball matches is \$6.00 for adults and \$4.00 for students.

A “miracle minute” free-will donations to benefit “Pink it Forward” will also be collected between sets of the varsity matchup.

This is the seventh year the annual Davies versus West Fargo volleyball matchup has raised funds to support a charitable organization. West Fargo won last year’s varsity matchup, 3-2. Last year the event raised more than \$5,000 for Kamp KACE.
