For the eighth year, Physical Education Teacher Ross Olson is conducting an ice skating unit for kindergarten through fifth graders. Each Thursday and Friday beginning Thursday, January 10, until February 15, Lincoln Elementary students will gather outside for their physical education class and enjoy either ice or boot skating.

The goal of the unit is to have students become more comfortable on the ice. Kindergarten through second graders must wear boots for the unit, while the upper grades will select either boots or skates dependent upon comfort level and skate size availability. Parents of Lincoln Elementary students will be volunteering to assist with tying ice skates.
