Students in grades 9–12 who are enrolled in Career and Technical Education (CTE) courses at South High School will hold an open house for their peers and parents on January 25 to showcase the automotive, manufacturing, and construction CTE courses available to all students.

In addition to displays for available courses, attendees will be invited to participate in a series of hands-on activities to test their skill level and knowledge of content areas. Some of the activities include:

- Various auto related activities and demonstrations.
- Computer Numeric Control demonstration along with a welding make-and-take.
- A Name That Auto Part contest.

Career and Technical Education curriculum is an essential component of the educational system, preparing students to be choice, career, and college ready upon graduation.
